I, TANNY WHITT, will my '47 Plymouth Coupe to BARRY PENNINGTON. Watch out, Barry, you might strip a North Cog."

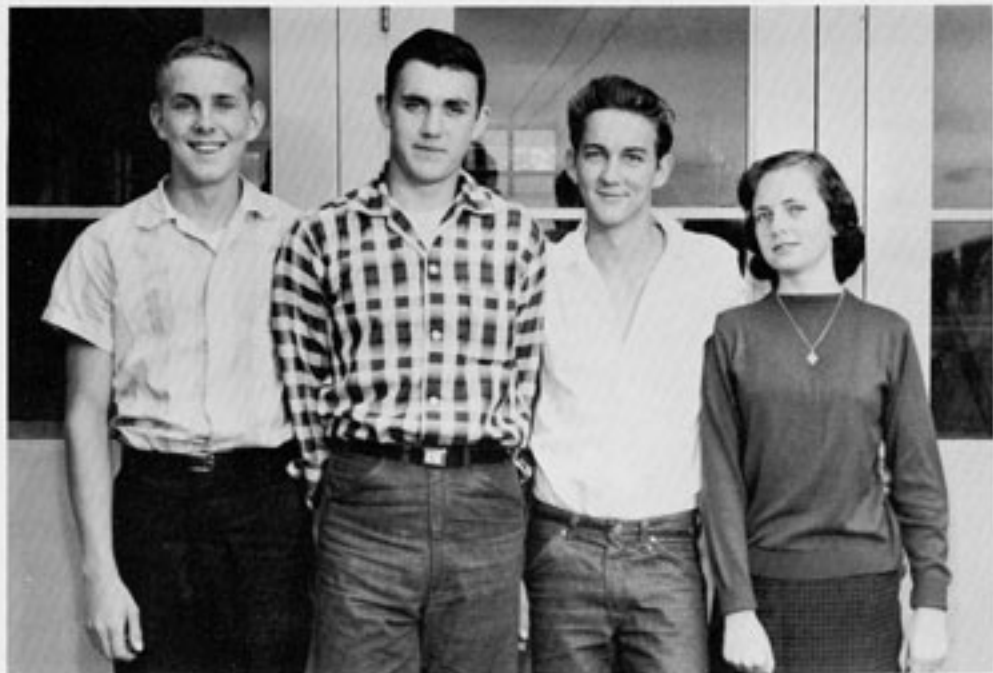

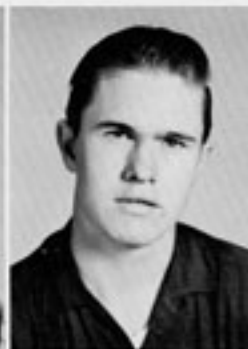

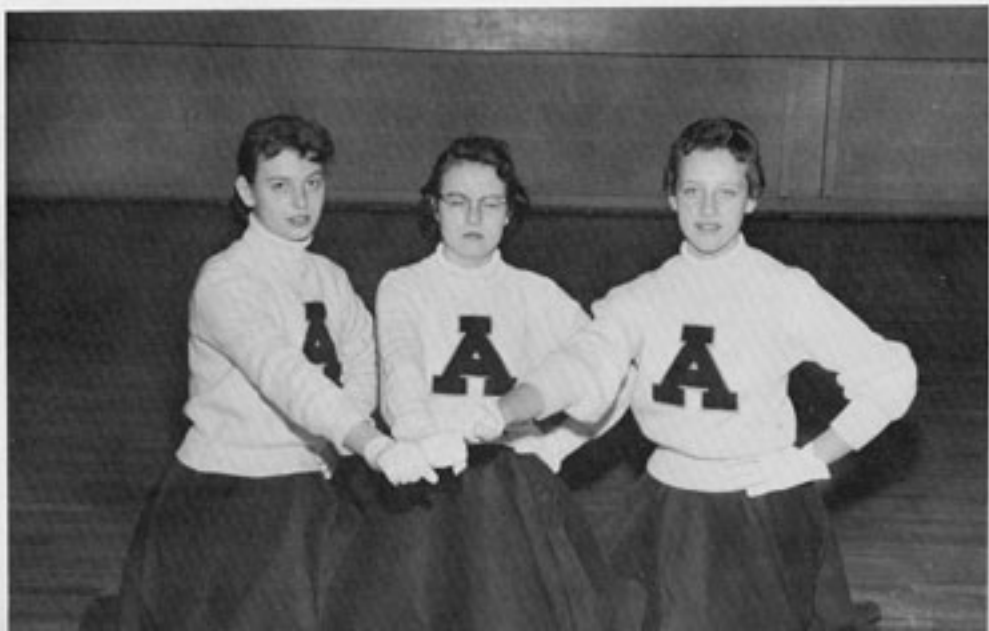
